Dear Parent,

With the aim of nurturing the artistic aptitudes of our children ranging from classical and folk dance, vocal and instrumental music, dramatics, poem recitation to public speaking or art, we at The Springfield Kindergarten are organizing a **Talent Hunt** in the Month of **January**. All children are welcome to showcase their talents and give wings to their dreams.

Kindly make a note of the following:

- Fill the acknowledgement slip and tick mark the talent your child is going to showcase, to your child’s class teacher by Sunday, the 9th January 2020.

Note: A student can choose to participate only in one event.

Instructions for the events:

1. Dance: Classical/Folk/Cinematic/Western

If your child is going to perform a dance, then kindly send the CD/USB of that particular song by 16th January 2020 for a screening. The CD/USB should be properly labelled with name and section. The performance should be limited to less than 2mints. Also, if the child has to wear any particular costume for the presentation then kindly send his/her set of uniform to change later on. Kindly label all the props or accessories to be used by the child. (Kindly refrain from selecting inappropriate Bollywood/Western songs).

Note: The dance, song and costume selected should abide the Qatar’s National norms. The costume and makeup should be done from home.



2. **Music:** Classical/ Light Music/ Instrumental

If your child wishes to participate for any instrumental music, kindly send the instrument along with your child labelled.

3. **Action Song:**

If your child chooses to participate in Action song, he/she can have props.

4. **Extempore:**

The topic for extempore is My Family/ My Teacher. Pros or posters will be allowed.

5. **Art & Craft:**

Clay Modelling/ Greeting Card Making/ Origami.

Note: All materials should be brought from home for this activity.
